

# ANJO TIMOTHY

## The Crop

Timothy is one of the latest heading of all cool season grasses with excellent palatability and winter hardiness as one of its most important features. Anjo is a medium maturing timothy variety with good yield potential, fast spring green-up and excellent disease resistance. This makes it an excellent choice in either pure timothy or mixed hay situations. Anjo has a semi-erect growth habit in the spring and very low potential for lodging, thus improving ease of mechanical harvest.

Excellent for: pure grass hay, especially into the horse market; the grass component in an alfalfa/grass hay mixture; and can be used for horse pasture mixtures.

## Management

- Planting Depth: 1/4 - 1/2 inch
- For optimum quality and yield, harvest at early boot stage

- Medium Maturity
- Quick Spring Green-up
- Excellent Disease Resistance

- Will match well with alfalfa and orchardgrass maturity
- Enables earlier harvest and better weed competition
- Healthier plants and better persistence.
